Application & Guidelines

The Mi'gmawei Mawiomi Business Corporation (MMBC) is proud to present a scholarship and bursary program to financially assist students whom are achieving academic success and in need of financial assistance. The MMBC acknowledges the importance of education for our First Nation members and therefore has developed a program to help students achieve their academic goals.

Scholarships awarded up to \$2,000 and Bursaries awarded up to \$1,000, per student – a limited number is available

Application Deadline:

- Submit to the MMBC office or by email by July 26th, 2019 at 12:00pm (noon) EST.
- Application must have all supporting documents attached in one package.
- Drop off application in-person or send in by email to: info@mmcorporation.ca
- Late or incomplete applications may not be accepted.

Eligibility:

- The <u>scholarship program</u> is meant for students who are in good academic standing and achieving a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 (B average) or higher and demonstrate a financial need.
- The **<u>bursary program</u>** is meant for vocational students and students who demonstrate a financial need.
- Scholarship and bursary applications are open to all First Nation students that are members from one of the three Mi'gmaq communities: Gesgapegiag, Gespeg, and Listuguj.
- Eligible applicants that will be considered are:
 - students that graduated from high school and furthering their education; or
 - students that will be attending or continuing post-secondary education; or
 - students that will be attending or continuing vocational training.
- Post-Secondary students must be attending an approved post-secondary institution on a full-time basis.
- Vocational students may only apply for the bursary program.
- Each applicant may only apply for <u>one</u> fund: scholarship or bursary.
- MMBC employees and board/committee members are not eligible.
